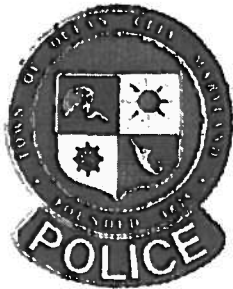

On July 14, 2014, at approximately 1144 hours, Cpl. Freddie Howard, responded to the complaint of check on the welfare at unit 3E of the Pyramid Condominium located at 9500 Coastal Highway. The complainant, Krista Marie Jeschke () contacted the Ocean City Police Department requesting to send an officer to check on her 13 years of age son, C (), who called Krista Jeschke telling her that his father, Curtis Lee Larrick (), Krista Jeschke's ex-husband, hit him and that he now wanted to leave Ocean City and to go home to Krista Jeschke's residence.

While at the Pyramid Condominium building parking lot area, Cpl. Howard contacted Krista Jeschke, who, at the time of the complaint, was in the State of Pennsylvania, to get additional information. During Cpl. Howard's conversation with Jeschke, Jeschke informed Cpl. Howard that several minutes earlier, (), who frequently has anxiety attacks and frequently gets into arguments with his father, Curtis Larrick, called her crying (Jeschke) from Ocean City saying that he and his dad had been arguing with each other for the past two days during their visit in Ocean City. However, according to () several minutes earlier, on the date of this request for Ocean City Police Department to check on Cole Larrick, Cole Larrick told Jeschke that () wanted to go back home to Pennsylvania because of the arguments between him and Curtis Larrick. According to Jeschke, Jeschke told () that she was not able to travel to Ocean City to pick () up. During her conversation with () continued to cry and, according to Jeschke, in light of ()'s anxiety condition, () seemed to have been making himself more upset. Prior to Jeschke ending the telephone call with () told Jeschke that Curtis Larrick intentionally struck () with Curtis Larrick's knee (Jeschke referred to as having kneed ()). Jeschke advised that although Curtis Larrick and () Larrick frequently get into arguments, which often results in () having an anxiety episode, Jeschke said that her ex-husband, Curtis Larrick, sometimes loses his temper, which she (Jeschke) said she reported to Curtis Larrick's place of employment, in the years past, with the Beaver County Sheriff's Office in the State of Pennsylvania.

In effort to understand the family circumstances involved, Cpl. Howard asked about the custody status of () who was advised to be the child of both Krista Jeschke and Curtis Larrick. Jeschke informed Cpl. Howard that Curtis Larrick has full custody of () throughout the week and that Jeschke typically has custody of Cole during weekend, but at the point of this complaint there was not any dispute over the custody court agreement. However, she (Jeschke) and Curtis Larrick, have been having ongoing civil disagreements related to the divorce and other family matters.

Krista Jeschke related that Curtis Larrick and () were also accompanied during the visit in Ocean City with Krista Jeschke's 17 years of age daughter, Annessia Marie Larrick (), and Curtis Larrick's friend and former co-worker, Matthew Allen Jones (). While Cpl. Howard was asking Jeschke about Matthew Jones for further investigative purposes, Krista Jeschke stated that she did not know much information about Matthew, except that he (Matthew) was Curtis' friend, at which time she also said, that she guesses Matthew was Curtis' friend, but he probably is Curtis' boyfriend, in what sounded to Cpl. Howard to be in a tone of bitter sarcasm.

When Cpl. Howard asked about the custody status about Annessia Larrick and if () k was Curtis' daughter, Jeschke sounded to give a sharp, "no, she () is not his (Curtis') daughter, she is my daughter," in a bitter tone as if Cpl. Howard insulted her by the very mentioning of () : having been Curtis' biological daughter rather than adoptive daughter.

Jeschke explained to Cpl. Howard that () < had a different birth father than her brother () and that Jeschke has full custody of () who resides with Krista Jeschke.

Cpl. Howard and Ofc. Wolf responded up to unit 3E of the Pyramid Condominium. Cpl. Howard knocked on the

door to the unit. Cpl. Howard observed [redacted] approach and answer the door. [redacted] had a surprised expression on his face at which time [redacted] began crying, seemingly as a result of having seen Cpl. Howard and Ofc. Wolf, in police uniform, having arrived to the residence. Cpl. Howard introduced himself to [redacted] and informed [redacted] that Cpl. Howard just spoke with his mother and that Cpl. Howard was there to speak with him and his father. However, while speaking with [redacted] at the front door in the foyer, [redacted] seemed emotionally calmed and stopped crying. Cpl. Howard did not see any health concerns or injuries to [redacted] informed Cpl. Howard that his father (Curtis), sister (Annessia) and Matthew were not at the residence, but outside on the beach. According to [redacted] he and his father were arguing the day before and this day just before calling his mother. [redacted] did not give any specifics at what his argument with his father was about other than that he [redacted] wanted to go home. [redacted] also related that during the argument, while he [redacted] was standing in the living room area of the unit, his father pushed and kned him [redacted] in the small area of his back. Cpl. Howard asked [redacted] if Cpl. Howard could see his back. [redacted] lifted up his shirt so that Cpl. Howard could see [redacted] s back. However Cpl. Howard looked very closely, but did not see any injuries or indications that would be consistent with [redacted] remark to his mother or Cpl. Howard that he was kned in the back. [redacted] did not show any indications that he was hurting or injured and appeared to walk and move normally.

While speaking to [redacted] Curtis Larrick, [redacted] k and Matthew Jones returned to the residence with beach items, appearing to have just come off of the beach.

Ofc. Philip Paterson arrived on the scene to assist Cpl. Howard with the investigation.

Cpl. Howard kept and spoke to the above mentioned individuals separately. Cpl. Howard spoke to and questioned Curtis Larrick about Krista Jeschke's stated concern about [redacted] and the comment that Curtis Larrick, having reportedly kned [redacted] a the back. According to Curtis Larrick, his son [redacted] had been debating and arguing with Curtis since they had arrived in Ocean City a couple days earlier because [redacted] would get upset when [redacted] did not get his way or do the things he [redacted] wanted do in general. However, Curtis Larrick was adamant that he did not assault or kned [redacted]. According to Curtis Larrick, it was [redacted] that kned Curtis Larrick, but Curtis Larrick did not wish to speak any further about that statement. Curtis informed Cpl. Howard that many times when [redacted] gets upset and mad with Curtis, [redacted] would call his mother (Krista) to pick him [redacted] up to go to Krista's house. And when [redacted] gets upset with his mother, while at her (Krista's) residence, [redacted] calls Curtis crying for Curtis to pick [redacted] up to take him [redacted] back home to Curtis' residence. During Cpl. Howard's questioning of Curtis, Curtis let Cpl. Howard listen to a past telephone message from [redacted] who sounded upset. On that message Cpl. Howard heard [redacted] leaving a message to Curtis asking his father (Curtis) to pick him [redacted] up from Krista's residence to take him home to Curtis' residence.

Curtis Larrick continued by telling Cpl. Howard that his ex-wife (Krista) and he (Curtis) have been in an ongoing family civil dispute through family court and that Krista Larrick has frequently attempted, according to Curtis, to get him (Curtis) into trouble by making complaints against him (Curtis) to police departments in Pennsylvania and the Beaver County, Pennsylvania, Sheriff Department where he (Curtis) works as a police officer. Curtis related that anything that [redacted] may have told Krista to prompt the police to respond to the residence may have been blown out of proportion or exaggerated by his ex-wife Krista to spite Curtis. Curtis let Cpl. Howard and Ofc. Paterson listen to a past voice message on Curtis' cell telephone from Krista. Although Cpl. Howard did not hear the message in its full context, Cpl. Howard could hear Krista angrily and uncontrollably yelling making statements referencing Curtis will be having to regret something or facing some sort of consequence. Ofc. Paterson remained with Curtis Larrick, while Cpl. Howard spoke with [redacted].

17 years of age, [redacted] told Cpl. Howard that her 13 years of age brother, [redacted] and Curtis always get into arguments back at home in Pennsylvania, just as they had been arguing for the past two days while visiting in Ocean City. According to [redacted] when [redacted] and Curtis argue, they both make her mad. [redacted] stated that sometimes

she feels that she is the only responsible person in the house. When Cpl. Howard questioned her () about what happened during the arguments between Curtis and Annessia did not mention or give any indication that anyone was assaulted during the argument. When Cpl. Howard questioned Annessia specifically about Cole's statements about having been pushed and kneed by Curtis, according to Annessia, many times when Cole and Curtis argue and when is mad at Curtis, e says things happened that really did not happen and exaggerates. Annessia then told Cpl. Howard that she did not see Curtis knee or push Cpl. Howard concluded the conversation with Annessia.

Cpl. Howard spoke to Matthew Allen Jones, who related the same information that ad been arguing with Curtis, because generally did not want to listen to Curtis' parental instruction and that Curtis frustratingly argued with and yelled at , but that Curtis did not Knee or push as mentioned.

Still out of the presence of the other above mentioned individuals, Cpl. Howard again spoke to Cole, who at this time was still calm and not upset. During Cpl. Howard's conversation with , told Cpl. Howard that was not afraid and that he just wanted to go home. Cole did not seem to wish to speak any further.

The above family was visiting the Ocean City, Maryland, area for the week from approximately July 12th to July 19th of 2014, while staying at unit 3E of the Pyramid Condominium located at 9500 Coastal Highway.

Based on Cpl. Howard's initial investigation, Cpl. Howard did not detect any criminal event or any immediate concern for the safety of or anyone else at the above mentioned location.

Although Cpl. Howard did not detect any criminal violation at the time of this initial investigation, in light of the ongoing family civil dispute related to the divorce; apparent parenting/child rearing disagreements between the ex-spouses' (parents); and the child's () above statements, Cpl. Howard will forward the above information to Social Services Child Protection Division to the local authorities in the State of Pennsylvania via Worcester County, Maryland, Social Services for further follow-up into the home and circumstances of the family and child. I Cpl. Howard will request the assistance of the Ocean City Police Department Criminal Investigation Division to facilitate the forwarding of the above events to Social Services and the appropriate law enforcement authorities in Pennsylvania.

The above events happened in Ocean City, Worcester County, Maryland.
